

WashingtonLakes.com Lake Sammamish Derby July 19,2009

Eligibility: Open to anyone. Any contestant under the age of 18 must have written permission from a parent or legal guardian to fish and participate with an adult during the event. This must be received by the time of registration.

Entry Fee: \$10.00 NON REFUNDABLE. \$15 day of the event. All persons in boat must be entered into the derby.

Equipment and fishing methods: All state and local laws as well as safe boating practices will be used at all times. UL approved life vest must be worn as required by state law and kill switches must be operational and attached to the outboard while running. Contestant banners (available at the drivers meeting) must be displayed on the outboard motor. Audible sound devices will also be required on every boat. Each boat must be equipped with an aerated live well if targeting bass. Acceptability of this will be left up to the tournament officials. Bass must be caught using artificial lures only. Trout may be caught with bait, but all WDFW regulations pertaining to trout caught with bait must be followed. If any bass are caught incidentally with bait they must be immediately and safely released. NO LIVE BAIT!!

Fishable waters: A contestant may not leave the boat to hook or land a fish. Contestants are not permitted to leave the boat in the effort to float their boat to areas that would be otherwise unreachable. Contestants that are shore-bound must fish public waters only in the Sammamish State Park. Shore-bound anglers may only fish for trout.

Scoring: Largest fish in either bass or trout species.

Eligible fish limit: Largemouth/smallmouth bass and trout are the only fish that will be permitted for the weigh-in. The derby limit will be 1 fish per species of bass, and best fish of a daily allowed limit of trout. Anglers may win prizes in both categories. This is a dual species event.

Protests: Protests regarding violations of these rules must be made immediately to the tournament officials and submitted in writing no later than one hour after the weigh-in has been completed. All decisions concerning protests will be at the discretion of the tournament officials and will be binding and final.

Officials: WashingtonLakes.com will designate tournament officials. All decisions of the tournament director and tournament officials shall be binding and final.

Boat Insurance: All boaters shall have boater's insurance coverage on their boats and passengers.

Aquatic Invasive Species: I certify that my boat and trailer have not been out of Washington State in the past 30 days. Angler's vessel shall not be allowed to be used in the Derby if it has been out of State in the past 30 days.

I/We have read, understood, and agree to abide by all the rules and regulations associated with the WashingtonLakes.com Lake Sammamish Open and hold harmless all sponsors, volunteers, tournament officials and WashingtonLakes.com from any and all claims for injury or damages.

I/We also agree that WashingtonLakes.com shall have exclusive rights to use any photographs and video recordings of myself, to use in any manner.

In signing this release, I/ WE do agree to submit to any verification testing provided by WashingtonLakes.com, and I/WE agree to abide by the decisions of the tournament officials.
